SFS will use the information provided on this application to determine your level of financial need and will offer aid based on that assessment. All students who exhibit financial need for their SFS program will receive some form of financial aid from SFS. When you submit this aid application, you will be considered for all types of SFS aid.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE APPLYING:

- In order to complete the following application, you must have a FAFSA on file with your home institution. Please contact SFS Billing billing@fieldstudies.org for further instructions if you attend a non-US institution or are not currently enrolled in a college/university.
- Be sure to ask your study abroad office or financial aid office what financial aid resources might be available at your home institution to support study abroad. It is your responsibility to understand the requirements, deadlines, and additional offerings of your home institution regarding financial aid for study abroad.

TO APPLY:

You will work with your study abroad office and/or financial aid office on campus to complete your SFS Financial Aid Application. Along with the attached form, you will need to submit the following two pieces of documentation:

- 1. The Student Aid Report (SAR) that you receive from FAFSA showing your Estimated Family Contribution (EFC).
- 2. **Documentation of any financial aid** you receive from your home school or external sources.
